Primary Objective of Position

To provide personal leadership and direction to the American Radio Relay League, Inc., consistent with the policies and directives established by its Board of Directors.

Accountability:

The President is accountable to the Board of Directors.

Major Areas of Responsibility:

1. Presides at meetings of the Board of Directors and the Executive Committee.
2. Actively supports the policies and directives of the Board of Directors to ensure their success, and monitors, continually, the execution of plans, programs, and schedules for meeting goals.
3. Participates in planning with Officers, Directors, and the Chief Executive Officer.
4. Keeps informed on Amateur Radio Service matters, both foreign and domestic, and assesses the current and future needs of the Amateur Radio Service.
5. Informs Officers and Directors continually regarding the status of planning, programs, policy matters, and prepares a semi-annual written report.
6. Represents ARRL in its relationships with the public and the various governments, governmental agencies, and officials with which the ARRL may be concerned.
7. Is an ex-officio member of all Standing Committees.
8. Provides assignments and direction for elected and honorary Vice Presidents.
9. Authorizes and approves Officer travel. Coordinates with the Chief Executive Officer membership contact, international travel, and the attendance of staff and Officers at conventions, hamfests, and meetings.
